Position Specific Training Courses for Cub Scout Leaders (**Tiger Den Leaders, Cub Scout Den Leaders, Webelos Den Leaders, Cubmasters, Pack Committee Members, and Pack Trainer**) will be conducted at CPCC's North Campus located at 11930 Verhoeff Drive (which is located between Highway 21 and Highway 115 in Huntersville) starting Thursday night, October 28th and concluding on Friday night, October 29th **from 7:30 pm until 9:30 pm each night** (i.e. each of these course will take **BOTH** evenings to complete).

Prerequisites for position specific courses are the relevant Cub Scout Fast Start course AND "This is Scouting" Cub Scout Fast Start and This is Scouting are available only as online courses from the BSA Online Learning Center. Links are provided at www.mcctraining.org under Online Training Courses.

If you have completed the prerequisites you will be able to earn the *Trained* patch by taking one of these Leader Specific Courses: Tiger Den Leader, Cub Scout Den Leader, Webelos Den Leader, Cubmaster, Cub Pack Committee Member, or Pack Trainer. A brief description of these courses is provided on the back of this form.

These courses offer in-depth details for fulfilling the responsibilities of the following leadership positions: Cubmaster, Pack Committee Member and Pack Trainer, as well as den leaders for the Tiger, Wolf, Bear and Webelos ranks. Please take this session within 60 days of accepting one of these positions. If you change positions, please take the training again, this time for your new position.

ALL REGISTERED LEADERS ARE REQUIRED TO TAKE YOUTH PROTECTION AT LEAST EVERY TWO YEARS. A link to this on-line course is available at www.mcctraining.org under Online Training Courses.

In addition to the position specific courses, **Youth Protection** will be taught from 6:30 pm until 7:30 pm on Thursday, October 28th and **Merit Badge Counselor Training** will be taught from 7:30 pm until 9:00 pm on Thursday, October 28th. No fee is required to take these courses, but advanced registration is requested.

Participants should come in uniform (if you have one), bring the Cub Scout Leader Book, pen and paper for taking notes, an enthusiastic attitude, and a willingness to have fun and learn!

The Training Committee reserves the right to cancel courses if an insufficient number of Scouters pre-register for a course.

CUB SCOUT LEADER POSITION SPECIFIC TRAINING

Since 2001, the National Committee has introduced several new training programs for adults. The program includes a series of specific trainings based on the various adult leadership positions within the Scouting organization. The program includes a short course for all registered adults called *This is Scouting*. **Completion of this training program fulfills the requirements to be considered as Trained to Position and earns you the right to wear the Trained patch.** The courses, and a recommended sequence, are as follows:

(1) Cub Scout Fast Start courses - These courses provide an overview of the operation of a Cub Scout pack and are the recommended first part of the training series for adult Cub Scout leaders and Pack Committee members. There are three different Fast Start courses: One for the Cubmaster; one for Pack Committee members, including the Pack Trainer; and one for Tiger Den Leaders, Cub Scout Den Leaders, and Webelos Den leaders. **A link is provided at www.mcctraining.org under Online Training Courses to the Cub Scout Fast Start courses.**

(2) *This is Scouting*- *This Is Scouting* is a new online training session that replaces New Leader Essentials. It picks up where Fast Start leaves off with six modules of training: The Mission of Scouting, Programs for All Ages, Scouting Is Fun, Scouting in the Community, Keeping Our Youth Safe, and Scouting's Legacy. The training takes about an hour to complete. (This course is the same for all adult leaders and only needs to be taken once, even if the leader changes positions or Scouting programs.) **A link is provided at www.mcctraining.org under Online Training Courses to *This is Scouting*.**

NOTE: If you have already taken New Leader Essentials (NLE), you do not have to take *This is Scouting*.

(3) Youth Protection Training - Youth Protection training is required for all leaders who have direct contact with youth. At all times, youth safety is the number one priority. At the same time, adults need to know the rules for keeping themselves safe, too. This comprehensive Youth Protection training teaches all the youth protections do's and don'ts of working with youth. The training is offered through the BSA Online Learning Center, or it may be taken as part of a council training course. **A link is provided at www.mcctraining.org under Online Training Courses to Youth Protection Training.**

(4) Cub Scout Leader Specific Training

- **Tiger Cub Den Leader Training**

Learn about running a Tiger Cub Den. Look at organization, recognition and program planning for the Den.

Prerequisite: *This is Scouting* or NLE and Den Leader Fast Start.

- **Cub Scout Den Leader Training**

Learn about running a Cub Scout Den. Look at organization, recognition and program planning for the Den.

Prerequisite: *This is Scouting* or NLE and Den Leader Fast Start.

- **Webelos Den Leader Training**

Learn about running a Webelos Den. Look at organization, recognition and program planning for the Den. Discuss the transition to Boy Scouts.

Prerequisite: *This is Scouting* or NLE and Den Leader Fast Start.

- **Cubmaster Training**

Learn about running a Cub Scout Pack. Look at organization, recognition and program planning for the whole Pack. **Prerequisite: *This is Scouting* or NLE and Cubmaster Fast Start.**

- **Pack Committee Member Training**

Learn how a Pack Committee should be organized, and the tasks which need to be completed by each member of the Committee. Learn how adult training and recognitions can make your Pack stronger.

Prerequisite: *This is Scouting* or NLE and Pack Committee Fast Start.

- **Pack Trainer**

Learn how the Pack Trainer, under the direction of the Pack Committee Chair, helps to provide a common point of contact within the Pack to answer leaders' and parents' questions about the purposes, policies, and procedures of the Cub Scout program.

Prerequisite: *This is Scouting* or NLE and Pack Committee Fast Start.
