		Is the tower straight (not leaning) and does it look to be in overall good shape?
		Is the tower secured, locked, and disabled to 12 feet?
		Are "Challenge Course" and/or CHECK signs posted clearly and in view of passersby?
		Are all poles free of decay or rot?
		Are the yellow guy wire sleeves in good condition?
		Are the guy wires in good condition (not overly loose, clamps in place, etc.)?
		Is the tower free from any obstruction on the ground (large rocks, branches, etc.)?
		Are the railroad ties bordering the rock garden in good condition?
		Is the pea gravel raked out from under the tower and spread evenly around the base of the tower routes?
		Is the area under the tower free from plant growth and animal nests?
		Is the paracord tied up and are the cleats in good condition?
		Are boards free of decay and splitting, free of excessive splinters?
		Is the tower free of protruding nails and screws?
		Are the plastic cleats for the removeable holds in good condition?
		Are climbing holds secured and tight to prevent slipping?
		Are the lights inside the tower working?
		Are the stairs and platforms clean and free of any debris?
		Are steps, stairs and handrails secured, steady and in good repair?
		Are rope/edge guards in good condition?
		Are railings at the top of the tower in good condition (to prevent someone from stepping off the edge of the tower)?
		Are the cables and clamps at the top of the tower in good condition?
		Is the tower free of active insect infestation, bees or wasp nest?
		Is the tower free of birds and nests?
		Zip Lines (only complete this section if used)
		Is the zip line dismount ladder in good working order?
		Is the zip line dismount platform in good condition and free of obstruction?
		Are the zip line termination poles free of decay or rot?
		Are the yellow guy wire sleeves in good condition?
