Maximum class size: 30 for each session

Costs: Entry to the Charlotte AutoFair and parking in the Youth Program area are **free** with registration in advance for tickets and parking passes.

Scout leaders and parents are welcome to attend.

Registration: Registration in advance is required to participate. Scout leaders must contact **Cheryl Cole** at (704 577 7398, email lakeholme@att.net) on or before the **deadline of Friday, August 26, 2022**, to allow mailing of the Charlotte AutoFair tickets and parking passes to Scouts and adults who will attend.

Blue cards: Each Scout must arrive with a blue card signed by a Scoutmaster to indicate permission to participate. Each Scout must leave their class with their blue card requirement grid filled out and signed or initialed by a Merit Badge Instructor or troop leader indicating requirements completed.

Home troops must identify registered Automotive Maintenance Merit Badge Counselors to work with Scouts to complete **requirements 8, 11, and 12** and to sign off full completions of their merit badges.
